FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Please ensure players arrive at their set registration time
- Players can either attend one or both trial dates
- All trials are held at Yokine Reserve, Yokine

What time does my child arrive at Yokine Reserve?	Please arrive 30 minutes before the trial is due to start to seek registration and a Trial Number.
What if my child can only make one of the trials?	Please attend as many trials as your availability allows. However, after the first two open trials conclude, opportunities are extended on an invitation only basis.
Can the Parent group watch the trials?	Yes, but please keep outside the marked boundary as the trials are a technical process for Football Staff and Players only. Parents are not to instruct, coach or direct players during training.
Do I need to accompany my child onto the field?	Once your child has signed in and received their trial number, the coaches will advise of the next step.
What is the trial number?	The trial number is written on the players hands to allow each player to be easily identifiable with the names on our registration list.
Are there any other avenues into the GDC?	Our GDC staff coach in all the Perth Glory Community & Development clinics including Holiday Programs, Skill & Development programs. Many players who have missed the trials or initial selection have gained selection into the GDC via other Perth Glory clinics.
What happens after the final trial?	After the final trial, coaching staff will collate their trial data. Parents will be advised of the next steps via email. As the GDC trials are a technical process, we will be unable to provide individual feedback to trialists.
